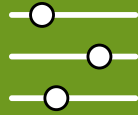

>>> RESOURCES

The backbone of CampDoc / SchoolDoc, the [List Builder](#) is a powerful tool that allows you to filter your Profile List to a subset of profiles that match specific criteria. You can filter for just about anything by adding one or more [conditions](#) (specific elements of a filter), including profiles with answers to specific questions asked in your Health Profile.

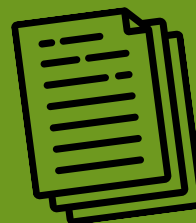

>>> CHART MEDICATION

Our Electronic Medication Administration Record (eMAR) ensures safe medication practices, minimizing errors by [tracking and documenting](#) medication administration.

You can record medication as given, not given, or pending. When marked as given, the current date and time appears. If administered later, you can specify the correct time. Errors can be corrected, with the medication reappearing in the administration list.

>>> FILTERS



Discover the power to streamline medication management with our eMAR. Effortlessly [filter](#) by participant, medication, date, time, groups, and [tags](#). Plus, save your preferred criteria for seamless use across your organization!



>>> REVIEWS AND NOTES

Reviews and Notes act as your team's internal communication channels. [Reviews](#) keep you informed about concerns or red flags, while [Notes](#) help you document and organize essential information for team collaboration.



Reviews help track important health considerations for participants. Are there severe allergies or dietary restrictions your organization needs to address? We recommend reviewing every health profile before the season starts.

Notes are akin to adding sticky notes to a paper file. They can cover various topics, and you can categorize, prioritize, and attach files to them.

>>> IMPORTANT NOTE ABOUT EMAR & HEALTH LOG

Because the eMAR is 'add-only' and limited to current participants, testing within that environment isn't possible. However, in response to demand, we've introduced [Sandbox Accounts](#). Now, your team can practice using the platform without impacting real participant data. This allows you to test the eMAR, Check-in/Attendance, Health Log features, and others stress-free!
